

MINUTES of the TOWN OF DAY MEETING

At TOWN OF DAY HALL on March 26, 2025

Joe Brueggen-X, Ron Kuehnhold-X, Chad Hoffman-X, Marc Griesbach-X, Dave Kraus-X.

Joe called the meeting to order at 7:01.

Guests: 6 as noted in the sign-in sheet

Minutes from February 19, 2025 were reviewed. Rebecca P. noted that the dips in the road were on her bus route and not on the road where she lives. Joan C-G. stated the number of military banners is 37 not 39. Chairman stated he would like to see the word payments spelled out in the minutes instead of the abbreviated form. Clerk will make the necessary corrections before forwarding it to the Chairman to post on the website. Chad made a motion to accept the minutes as amended, 2nd by Ron. M/C

Payments were reviewed. Chad made a motion to pay the bills, Ron 2nd. M/C

Treasurer's Report: Marci stated the checking balance on February 28th was \$582,180.12. As of today, it is \$148,877.16. Hall loan balance \$17,544.34, road loan balance \$490,212.09. Deposits in February were \$10,059. She noted that even with dump prices increased in December we are still losing money there.

Correspondence: DOR sent a letter to the Town stating that we owed \$35.30 for reconciliation of the W-7 reports for 2024. The clerk paid it. IRS letter - the Town is still having trouble with the 4th Qtr. 941 report from 2023. The IRS claims they never received it. The clerk sent another 941 report to them, documented and copied all the information that was sent.

Burning Permit: Two burning permits were issued.

Driveway/Culverts permits: Rick Bangart

Public Comment: Ron K. wanted to know who plowed the parking lot and pushed stones onto the grass. Joe said he did. It was heavy snow and hard to control the plow. Joe received a note asking for granite on North Rd. He has asked the DNR for money to help apply granite on North Rd and is waiting for an answer.

Joan C-G. had 5 Christmas banners on display tonight. She will be bringing them to the annual meeting in April. Joan stated the deadline for ordering military banners is April 1, 2025. Joan asked who oversaw cutting brush or small trees away from posts that block the view of the banners. Joan also needs more brackets for banners. Ron stated he had some at home.

Tom S. suggested Joe call Jim Griesbach about the brush and trees near the poles.

Joe received some calls from residents saying it was nice to have the roads plowed by Monday morning before they had to go to work.

Road Commission: Chad noted weight limit signs are posted. He oversees giving out special permits to use posted roads. The commission will be keeping an eye on the roads as they thaw to assess what shape they are in.

Plan Commission: Joe said the commission is nearly done with the draft. NCRPC will be looking into zoning codes for the town.

Continuous Business:

Sanitation District: Tom S. gave a report on the sanitary district. He said the system is over 50 years old, but in relatively good shape. Their 5-year permit has just been renewed. He then answered various questions about the sanitary system and ended by stating that the DNR controls everything.

Roads: Stated above.

LRIP: The LRIP program will only cover the costs of Oxbo Road, a mile west of County Road M and about a mile north on Folz Road. Joe estimated the cost to finish the project all the way to Eau Pleine Rd would be about \$8000. Chad made a motion to finish the LRIP project all the way to Eau Pleine Rd, 2nd Ron. M/C

Plan Commission: Joe stated the commission is at the point where they need to map out the township. They do not have the materials to do this. Chad made a motion to pay NCRPC \$500 to map out the township, 2nd by Ron. M/C

The planning commission adopted a Public Participation Plan resolution which the clerk signed and will post. Chad made a motion to do so, 2nd by Ron. M/C

Joe mentioned there is an open position on the planning commission. Anyone interested should let him know.

Wind Update – Brighton: Brighton was ready to dismiss their case, but then found they have a court date on June 24, 2025.

New Business:

Bids: Joe has been getting calls wondering about our granite and lawn mowing bids. The clerk will get these out as soon as Joe approves them.

Culvert replacement: We have culverts to replace on the corner of County Road C & Veerland Lane, Guldán St. west off Rangeline Road, 2 on East McMillian and one at the intersection of Oxbo Road & County Road M.

Chad made a motion to adjourn, at 8:16, 2nd by Ron. M/C
