**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DEPOSIT OF SNOW OR OTHER MATERIALS
ON OR ACROSS TOWN HIGHWAYS**

The Town Board of the Town of Day, Wisconsin, pursuant to § 60.10 and 82.03(1)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes does ordain as follows with regard to its Town roads:

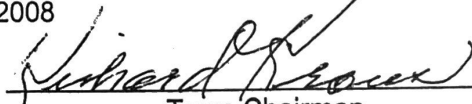
1. **Unlawful to Deposit Snow**
No person, firm, partnership or corporation shall allow the piling or pushing of snow or other materials from their private drives or parking areas onto or across any highway within the Town of Day.
2. **Definitions**
For the purpose of this ordinance, the word "highway" is defined as all public ways and thoroughfares and bridges on the same. It includes the entire width between the boundary lines of every way open to the use of the public as a matter of right for the purpose of vehicular travel.
3. **Enforcement**
The Town Board and such other town representative as designated by the Town Board, are hereby authorized to enforce this ordinance, and to issue citations for violations of this ordinance pursuant to applicable state statutes.
4. **Penalties**
Any person, firm, partnership or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance will be assessed the cost of removal. In addition, they shall be liable under Wis. Stat. section 346.95(3) to a fine of \$50.00 for each occurrence.

This ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its passage and publication as provided by law.

Any previous ordinances or resolutions in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
