

RESOLUTION 2025-3

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF DAY TO: TERMINATE EXISTING FIRE PROTECTION AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES CONTRACT AND TRANSFER SERVICES FOR ALL SECTIONS OF THE TOWNSHIP TO STRATFORD AREA FIRE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the Town of Day is responsible for providing fire protection services to its residents pursuant to Wis. Stat. § [60.55 or 61.65]; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Day has identified a need to consolidate all fire protection services and emergency medical services (EMS); and

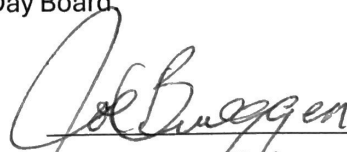
WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed alternatives for fire protection services and EMS currently provided by the Auburndale Joint Fire and Rescue Department to three sections of the township and finds that it is in the best interest of the Town of Day to terminate this contract. On January 1, 2026, the Town of Day will transfer these services to the Stratford Area Fire Department which currently provides fire protection and EMS to all other sections of the Town of Day; and

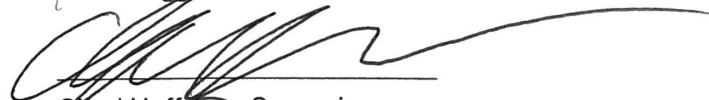
WHEREAS, the consolidated services will provide faster response times for fire and EMS calls, as Auburndale Joint Fire and Rescue Department has taken on additional service areas.

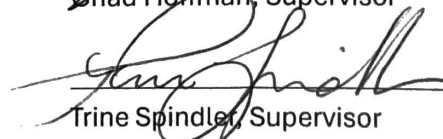
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of the Town of Day, Marathon County, Wisconsin, that:

1. The Board hereby approves and directs the Town Chair to transfer all fire protection services and emergency medical services provided to the township, to the Stratford Area Fire Department.
2. The Town Chair is further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate this resolution.
3. The Municipal Clerk is directed to provide notice of this resolution to all relevant parties, including the Auburndale Joint Fire and Rescue Department and the Stratford Area Fire Department.
4. The Board authorizes the necessary budget amendments to fund the new fire protection services and emergency medical services.

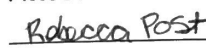
