

**TOWN OF DAY, MARATHON COUNTY, WISCONSIN
REGULAR BOARD MEETING MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, MARCH 18, 2026**

Call to Order

Chairman Brueggen called the meeting to order at 7 pm.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll Call

Present: Chairman – Joe Brueggen, Supervisor – Chad Hoffman, Clerk – Rebecca Post, Treasurer – Marci Griesbach. Absent: Supervisor – Trine Spindler

Approval of Agenda

Motion (Hoffman/Brueggen) to accept agenda as written. Motion carried.

Approval of Minutes

Motion (Hoffman/Brueggen) to accept minutes from March 4, 2026. Motion carried.

Approval of Payments

Motion (Hoffman/Brueggen) to accept payments as written. Motion carried.

Reports

- Treasurer Report: Treasurer Griesbach provided information regarding deposits, loan totals, and account balances. Checking balance as of March 17, 2026: \$234,538.38.
- Clerk Report: Clerk Post stated the Spring Election is on April 7.
- Plan Commission Report: Provided by Brian Dillinger, Plan Commission Chair. At their meeting tonight they approved a memo to the Town Board regarding Policy and Procedures for Zoning Administrator and chose a nominee for Zoning Administrator. Two positions on the Plan Commission will be up for renewal next month. Working on a Battery Energy Storage System Ordinance.
- Road Commission Report: Provided by Supervisor Hoffman. Will assess damage to the roads after the snow melts. The following helped with snow removal during the recent historic snowstorm: Travis Karl, Jamie Kloos, Scott Kloos, Steve Kloos, Chad Kraus, Chad Hoffman, Brian Dillinger and Joe Brueggen.
- Intergovernmental Committee Report: Provided by Jackie Dillinger. They had a speaker on comprehensive plans.

Public Comment

- Tom Karl - Liked updates on Facebook about the roads and stated that Highway 97 is in bad condition for a state highway.
- Ron Hartle - Saw our grader/trucks moving before the county was out clearing roads.
- Jill Stoflet – Commented on communication in general – messages getting out on Facebook are great. She asked who to contact to get no parking signs across from restaurants.
- Matthew Boor with Alliant Energy provided addenda to the informational binders previously provided to the Town. They will have an open house during the week of May 20. They would like to extend the timeframe on the current MET tower and leave it up an additional 24 months.
- Ron Kuehnhold asked when Marathon County is going to fix Highway C in Rozellville.

Continued Business

- Kyle Ule has been hired as the new Road Maintenance Worker and will start March 30. He is a resident of Day.
- Motion (Hoffman/Brueggen) to adopt Resolution 2026-04 To Amend Fee Schedule to make operator's license \$15 for one year. Motion carried.
- Motion (Hoffman/Brueggen) to accept example 1 of operator's license application with a fee of \$15. Motion carried.
- Motion (Hoffman/Brueggen) to accept feedback of what attorney said for the Ordinance No. 2026-01 and go back to the original verbiage that also included the attorney's recommended changes. Motion carried.
- Renewable Energy: Chairman Brueggen stated nothing has been submitted yet to the PSC. When asked when they plan to submit permits, Matthew Boor from Alliant said their intent is to submit a CPCN in late August 2026. If the PSC approves everything with no issues, the earliest the project would be projected to start is August 2027. Project boundaries have been determined. Matthew stated they don't have mapping of the layout of turbines; further studies will determine final turbine placement. When asked if the map covers all six towns that were originally listed as it has been heard that some towns won't be getting a wind energy system, Matthew said he couldn't confirm or deny that right now as it's based on the environmental studies.
- Clerk Post and Supervisor Spindler met with JB Systems to discuss additions, deletions and layout of the new website. The goal is to have it ready by annual meeting.
- Motion (Hoffman/Brueggen) to approve the Town of Day zoning code and zoning map. Motion carried.
- Motion (Hoffman/Brueggen) to accept Ordinance No. 2026-02 to adopt the Town of Day Zoning Code and Zoning Map. Motion carried.

New Business

- Motion (Hoffman/Brueggen) to approve the Zoning Policy and Procedures for Zoning Administrator. Motion carried.
- Motion (Hoffman/Brueggen) to approve Resolution No. 2026-05 Appointment of Zoning Administrator. Motion carried.
- Motion (Hoffman/Brueggen) to accept the nomination by the Plan Commission of Brian Dillinger as Zoning Administrator for a one-year term until the next election cycle. Motion carried.
- Motion (Hoffman/Brueggen) to adopt Ordinance No. 2026-03 Adoption of Residential and Commercial Building Codes. Motion carried.
- Liquor license packets are being put together to be distributed. The Department of Revenue has made changes to the forms again this year.
- Chairman Brueggen addressed the letter sent to Town residents by concerned citizens.
- Chairman Brueggen stated that Governor Evers put out a declaration of emergency for Marathon County. Chairman Brueggen will submit information to the county as we may be able to claim emergency aid for March 15-16.
- Motion (Hoffman/Brueggen) to approve the Intergovernmental Committee Bylaws. Motion carried.
- Items to consider for next agenda: annual meeting format, disaster relief update, email and laptop for zoning administrator.

Motion (Hoffman/Brueggen) to adjourn at 9:35 pm. Motion carried.
