

**TOWN OF DAY, MARATHON COUNTY, WISCONSIN
REGULAR BOARD MEETING MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, APRIL 1, 2026**

Call to Order

Chairman Brueggen called the meeting to order at 7 pm.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll Call

Present: Chairman – Joe Brueggen, Supervisor – Chad Hoffman, Clerk – Rebecca Post, Treasurer – Marci Griesbach. Absent: Supervisor – Trine Spindler

Approval of Agenda

Motion (Hoffman/Brueggen) to approve agenda as written. Motion carried.

Approval of Minutes

Motion (Hoffman/Brueggen) to approve minutes from March 18, 2026. Motion carried.

Public Comment

- Joan Carey-Gebelein asked if there are weight limitations in regard to Highway C.

Continued Business

- Chairman Brueggen said Marathon County is eligible for disaster aid due to the recent snowstorm. He submitted cost information to the county which was accepted by the state. The state will reimburse up to 70% of eligible costs, which will go toward the temporary workers who helped out.
- Discussed need to for a laptop for the zoning administrator and a new printer for the office. Motion (Hoffman/Brueggen) to spend up to \$1500 on a laptop, printer and wireless mouse to be used in the Zoning office. Motion carried.
- Alliant Energy's meteorological tower (MET) is up for renewal. They will need to submit a permit for review and the Plan Commission will need to have a public hearing.
- There will be a white goods (appliances) collection day on May 9 from 9 am – 12 pm at the town dump. This will be for Town of Day residents only.
- Renewable Energy – Nothing changed except the MET tower and application. Alliant Energy is having an open house at The Belvedere the week of May 20.
- The Plan Commission will continue to work on a Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) Ordinance. The PSC is looking to develop guidelines for BESS.

New Business

- Motion (Hoffman/Brueggen) to go back to meeting just once a month, the 3rd Wednesday of the month. Motion carried.
- There has been positive feedback from residents regarding the calendar dates on the website and Facebook page. We will continue to do this.
